

VANCOUVER RIFLE AND PISTOL CLUB
SAFETY RULES
Revised January 2007

SAFETY IS EVERYONES' RESPONSIBILITY. ANY MEMBER NOT FOLLOWING THE SAFETY RULES MAY LOOSE HIS/HERS MEMBERSHIP IN THE CLUB.

1. Always consider and handle all firearms as though loaded and ready to fire.
2. Never allow the muzzle of a firearm to point anywhere except downrange when the firearm is uncased.
3. Keep your finger off the trigger and out of the trigger guard until ready to fire.
4. Be sure of your target and what lies near and beyond it.
5. **Eye and ear protection is required for anyone in the firing line area, shooting or not.**
6. Firearms must be cased, holstered or slung with actions open during transport to/from the firing line.
7. All shots MUST impact the bullet trap.
8. In order to go forward of the firing line, ALL firearms must be made "safe".
9. **ALL FIREARMS MUST BE UNLOADED WITH DETACHABLE MAGAZINES REMOVED BEFORE GOING FORWARD OF THE FIRING LINE. DO NOT TOUCH ANY FIREARMS WHILE PEOPLE ARE FORWARD OF THE FIRING LINE.**
10. Do not shoot at an angle. Shoot only at the target directly downrange of your position on the firing line.
11. No shotgun shooting Remove targets from target holders, throw in the garbage, and pick up your brass when finished shooting.
12. Juvenile shooters (under 18) must be directly supervised by a competent adult.
13. No alcohol or persons suspected to be under the influence of alcohol/drugs are allowed on club property.
14. Report to any Board Member any incidents of members not enforcing or following the safety rules.
15. **NO JACKETED AMMO MAY BE SHOT ON OUR RANGE.**
16. **NO AMMO MAY BE SHOT THAT EXCEEDS 1000 FEET PER SECOND.**
17. **NO 17HMR AMMO MAY BE SHOT ON OUR RANGE.**
18. You are responsible for the guest(s) you bring to the range. There is a \$2.00 fee for all guest(s).
